

# Wild Summer Roses

## Supplies - -

Background - 1 fat quarter - cream  
Basket & handle - 2 fat quarters - 2 shades of brown  
Flowers - - 2 shades - 5" squares reds ( or your color choice)  
Leaves - - 2 shades - 5" squares greens  
1/4 yd of Wonder Under for flowers and leaves

## Cutting - - -

### Background

1 sq - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"  
2 rectangles - 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"  
2 sq - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"  
1 sq - 3" x 3"

### Basket

\* Light brown  
3 sq - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"  
1 sq - 3" x 3"  
\* Dark brown  
2 sq - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"  
1 bias strip - - 1 inch wide X 14 inches long

## Trace - -

Trace the Roses and leaf shapes onto the Wonder Under. Rough cut the shapes out and then place on wrong side of corresponding fabrics, press in place with a DRY iron (not steam).

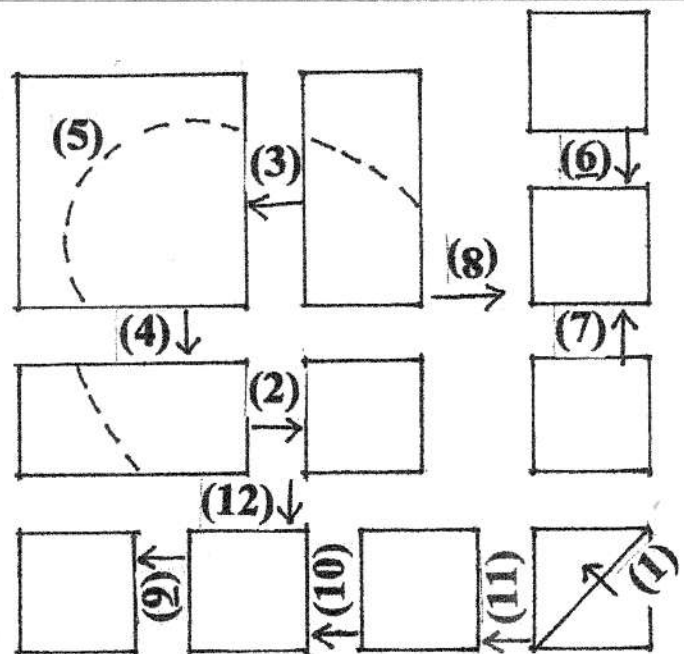
Cut out and lay aside until basket is constructed and you are ready to press the flowers and leaves onto the basket.

## Assembly - -

Lay out all pieces for square minus flowers and leaves. Follow the number sequence for assembling the square and also note the arrow beside the number. This indicates the direction to press the seam allowance.

1. Place 3 inch squares right sides facing, sew diagonally and then cut for the triangle square-(basket bottom)

5. Sew folded in half length bias strip (handle) down to background and press over raw edges. Then applique down edge by hand or machine.



Then place Roses and leaves in a pleasing placement for you and then press with a steam iron to set the fusible. Zig zag the edges of flowers and leaves.
